

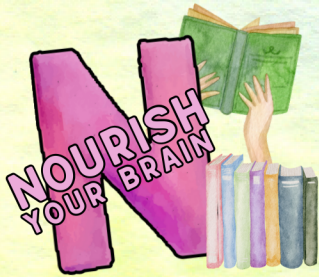
SUMMER PENGU IS BACK!!!!
