When is our SERVE-A-THON?

Our SERVE-A-THON will take place on Friday, October 27, 2023. Our month-long calendar will kick-off on Friday September 29, 2023 at 2:30pm.

How does a SERVE-A-THON work?

A SERVE-A-THON is a SERVICE & FUNdraising effort. Starting right after the kick-off event, students are asked to reach out to family and friends asking them for pledges and donations to help our school. During the month of October, each class will be participating in 30-Days of Random Acts of Kindness and preparing for a daily service opportunity. On the day of the event, all classes will be "sharing their blessings" out in the community.

What will the students be doing during the SERVE-A-THON?

Each class will be participating in 30-Days of Random Acts of Kindness and will decide, as a class, on any other service opportunity they would like to participate in. The final service activity will be an all-school community event.

What should my student wear for SERVE-A-THON on Friday, October 27, 2023? Please have your student dress in their uniform or St. Jude of the Lake School

Serve-A-Thon t-shirt (provided) with uniform bottoms.

How much time will the students be devoting to the SERVE-A-THON?

We have devoted part of each day to working on our random acts of kindness. The time spent on each community service project will vary, there might be some preparations to do done beforehand but the activities will not impact their core subjects learning time.

What is the St. Jude of the Lake School Blessing Box?

As a school and parish, the idea of the Blessing Box is that anyone who passes by it, that is down on their luck, can take what they need to get through the day. The box will be filled with non-perishable food and personal hygiene items. This is not a food shelf. Tough luck hits everyone at one time or another, sometimes only lasting a day or two. Each classroom will be assigned and responsible for 1-month to make sure the box is taken care of and has plenty of "blessings" to share. They will also write personal notes and decorate prayer cards. We want to stress to our students that showing little and random acts of kindness really can make a huge difference in someone's life.


Do we have a FUNdraising goal in mind?
