We have a strategic plan that is a working and always evolving document. The current strategies and action steps we are concentrating our efforts on are listed below. \*We are coming to the end of our 7-year school strategic plan cycle this year. We will be going through re-accreditation in the Spring and will be implementing a new school strategic plan upon completion of the process.

 Expand our marketing efforts and enrollment strategies to increase and retain enrollment.

We continue to increase our visibility in print and social media and continue to make great strides in building our partner relationship with St. Jude of the Lake Discovery Center. Our Penguin Power is shining bright!

 Develop a school-wide professional development plan.

As a staff, we are looking at and researching a variety of professional development opportunities in the areas of reading, math and science. We have implemented a Staff Development Series each month to introduce and facilitate innovative and engaging ideas that the staff takes ownership of and is excited about.

 Identify consistent means of funding for professional development and provide progress reports.

Future funding ideas are a crucial part of the business plan shared with all potential donors. A deliberate effort is being made to provide all our stakeholders and families with up-to-date information that is going on in our school. We are currently working on growing our school endowment fund.

 Investigate different and sustainable funding models to support educational programs.

We are being very diligent and aggressive in fundraising and our school endowment efforts. We have a team of enthusiasts identified and who are willing to help cast out our net and build up financial sustainability.

• Use assessment data in a consistent manner to quide curriculum and instruction decisions.

We are more deliberate in our communication with students and parents on state - wide standards, curriculum and strategies. We are using, several different methods of assessment to help us better serve our students needs with and to help create their personalized learning plans. These efforts include better use of technology, collaboration with other teachers and a variety of hands-on assessment tools.

#### PENGUINS IN OUR PRIME CURRICULUM PROGRAM

At St. Jude of the Lake Catholic School, we're committed to creating inspiring and engaging learning experiences for everyone on our lifelong learning journey together.

Our curriculum is hands-on and faith-based, incorporating various subjects and resources to provide a well-rounded education. We teach Word Of Life Religion, Rua Woods Theology of the Body, literacy skills using SuperKids and Reading Side By Side, language arts, handwriting, Envision math, FOSS Science Next Generation, STEM, and TCI Social Studies.

This year, we're excited to continue offering on-site counseling through the Phoenix Institute, thanks to the Catholic School of Excellence Grant called "Peace of Mind". This grant not only provides counseling but also supports staff development, offers parent education, monthly videos, and on-site presentations.

For grades 3-8, we've introduced the Studio 3:16 Program, which is an entertaining educational series based on gospel passages. It helps students discover Christ and strengthen their virtues, faith, and understanding of truth. Middle school students are enjoying the Amplify ELA curriculum and the Northern Lights Series from the Minnesota Historical Society. Additionally, we're excited to introduce the Social Institute program, which helps students navigate social media and prioritize their health and wellness.

All our students participate in Mass, Library, STEM/Technology, Art, Music, Physical Education, and Spanish classes weekly. We utilize technology extensively, including iPads, SMART boards, Apple TVs, coding opportunities, STEM challenges, and 3-D printing.

In addition to our dedicated staff, we have support staff to assist students in reinforcing concepts and skills at their own pace. We also offer various programs such as service learning, Lego robotics, the LINKs Program (Life Involves New Kinds of Skills). Engineering Is Elementary, and even an outdoor classroom.

It's clear to see that there's a lot of "Penguin Power" shining at our school, and we're excited to continue this educational journey with you!





At St. Jude of the Lake, we believe in the power of continuous academic growth. Our students take the **Northwest Evaluation Association's (NWEA)** standardized tests known as **The Measure of Academic Progress (MAP)**. These computer-administered tests help us measure each student's learning progress over time, reported in RIT units.

The RIT scale provides a stable measure of student performance, much like feet and inches, allowing us to accurately gauge achievement levels regardless of age or grade. We're thrilled to share that our students have shown exceptional performance, with average scores in math, reading, and language usage surpassing the national average.

For Spring 2023, our Language Usage Assessment revealed that forty-nine percent of students in grades 2-5 scored at the 60th percentile. In the Reading Assessment for kindergarten through seventh grade, an impressive sixty percent scored at or above the 60th percentile. Additionally, sixty percent of our students in kindergarten through seventh grade\* scored at or above the 60th percentile in the K-12 math assessment. Notably, every student who took the Algebra 1 Assessment scored at or above the 89th percentile. In the Science Assessment for grades three through seven, an impressive sixty-six percent of our students scored at or above the 89th percentile.






